You will need: - #8 cotton thread 3mm crochet hook 43 x 6-8mm beads beading needle

- **UK** terms are used throughout. Assumes some crochet knowledge.
- Start by threading all 43 beads onto your crochet cotton with a beading needle.
- Chain 5, join with a slip stitch.
- Join each round with a slip stitch.

Round 1 - ch1, db cr 13 into ring. Join with a sl st to first chain. (14st)

- Rd 2 ch 2, tr cr 3 tog over next 2 stitches, ch 3. **tr cr 4 tog over next 2 stitches, ch3.* Rpt from * to end. (7 clusters of 4)
- Rd 3 ch 1 *db cr 3 into next ch sp, ch 1. Rpt from * to end. (29 st)

Rd 4 - ch 3, *tr cr 1, ch 1 into next st. Rpt from * to end. (29 st)

Rd 5 - ch 1, *db cr 2 into next ch sp. Rpt from * to end. (58 st)

- Rd 6 ch 2, tr cr 3 tog over next 2 stitches, ch 3. *tr cr 4 tog over next 2 st, ch 3. Rpt from * to end. (29 clusters)
- Rd 7 ch 1, db cr 2 into ch sp. *db cr 3 into next ch sp. Rpt from * to end.
- Rd 8 ch 5, sk 1 st *tr cr 1 into next st, ch 2, sk 1 st. Rpt from* to end. (43 tr cr)

Rd 9 - ch 1, *db cr 2 in next ch sp. Rpt from * to end. (86 st)

Rd 10 - ch 2, tr cr 3 tog over next 2 stitches, ch 3 *tr cr 4 tog over next 2 st, ch 3. Rpt from * to end. (43 clusters)

Rd 11 - **ch 2, sl st around bead, ch 2, db cr 1 into next ch sp.* Rpt from * to end. (43 beads) Cut thread and pull end through to close.
